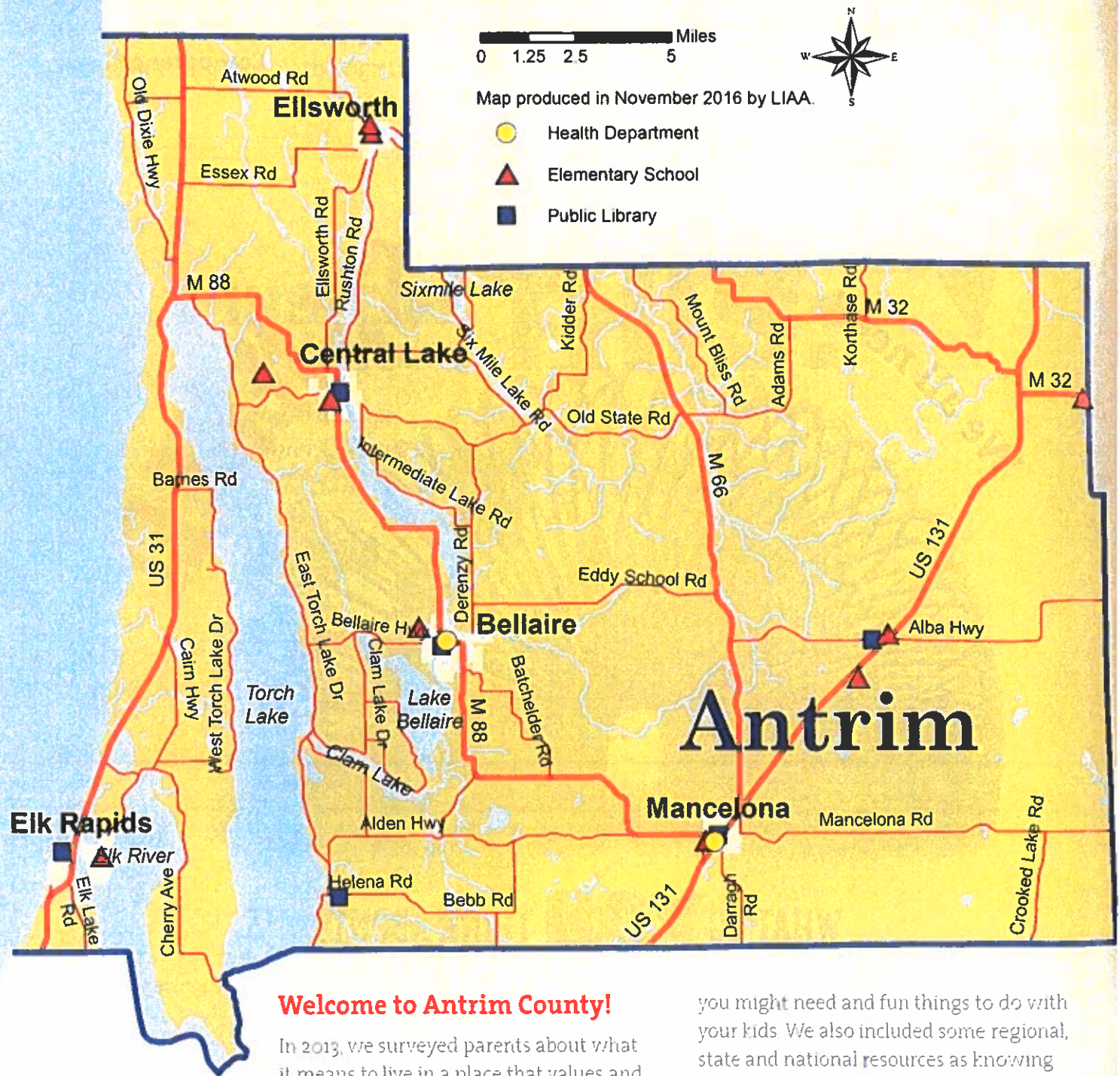


ANTRIM COUNTY
