Information from Superintendent and Administrators

- All K-12 schools in Michigan have been required to close starting Monday, March 16th, for three weeks. Classes will resume Monday, April 6, 2020.
- KPS Food Service will be providing food for students starting 3-16-2020 through 3-26-2020. Food can be picked up at the High School, south side, Dresden Street from 11:00 a.m. – 1:00 p.m. Families can get two days of food at a time. It would be very helpful if parents could email food service director, Jenny Patton with number of meals that will be picked up. We want to be as prepared as possible.
- Transit will be delivering food for students to the following locations (dates and times shown also):
 - o CETA Hall: 3-16, 3-18, 3-20, 3-23 and 3-25-2020 from 11:00 - 11:30 a.m.
 - o Lodi Trading Company: 3-16, 3-18, 3-20, 3-23 and 3-25-2020 from 11:00 - 11:30 a.m.
 - o Excelsior Twp Hall: 3-16, 3-18, 3-20, 3-23 and 3-25-2020 from 11:00 - 11:30 a.m.
 - o Save A Lot: 3-16, 3-18, 3-20, 3-23 and 3-25-2020 from 11:00 - 11:30 a.m.
- Parent teacher conferences are cancelled for spring 2020. If you wish to speak with your child's teacher/teachers, once school resumes, please contact them.
- No practice for any sports starting Monday, March 16th. As of now, practice will resume April 6, 2020.
- KPS will not have latchkey or SEEDS programs until school resumes on April 6, 2020.
